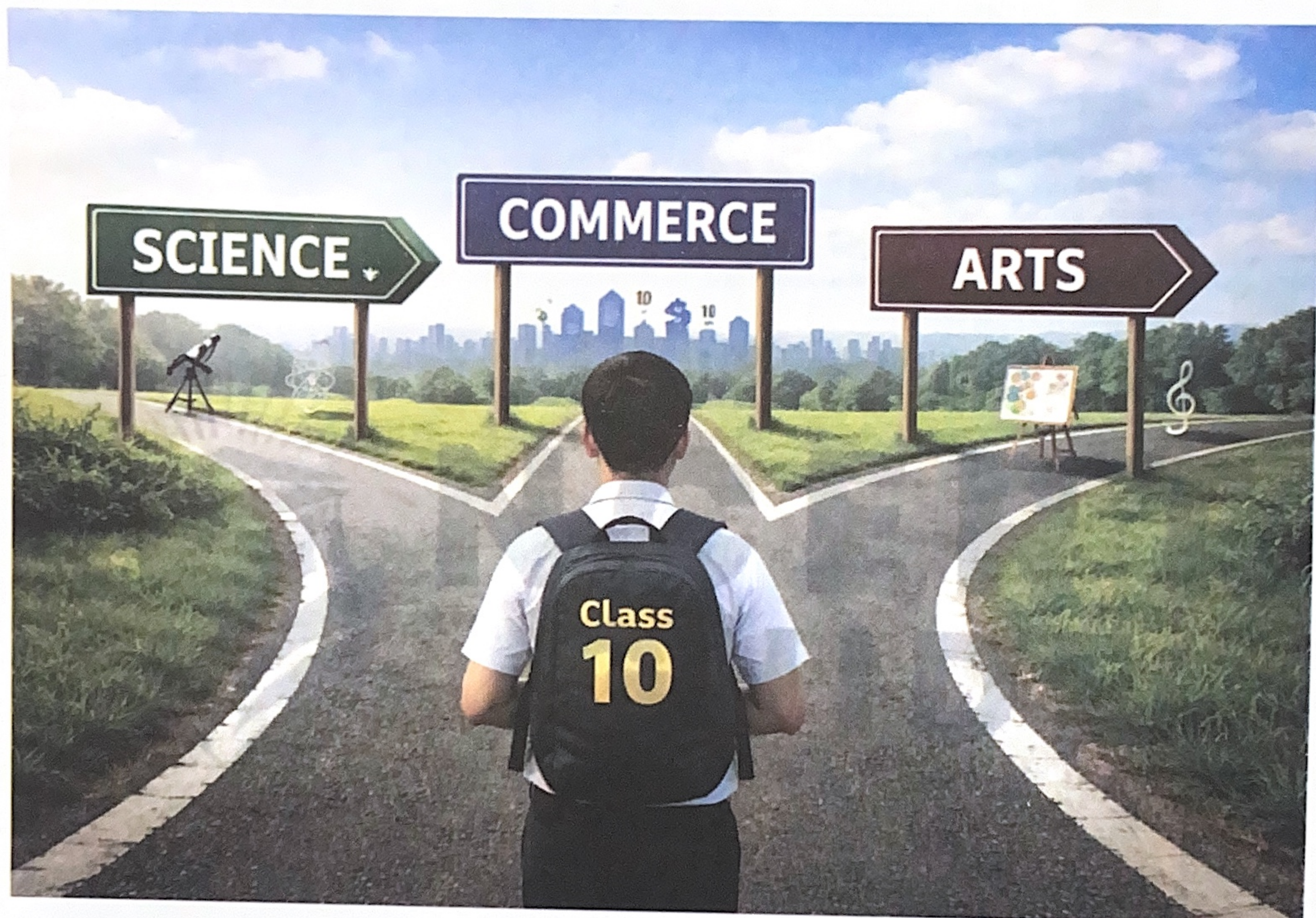


CHAPTER:1

Class 10 is one of the most important stages in a student's life. After completing the 10th board examinations, students are required to make their first major academic decision — choosing a stream for further studies.

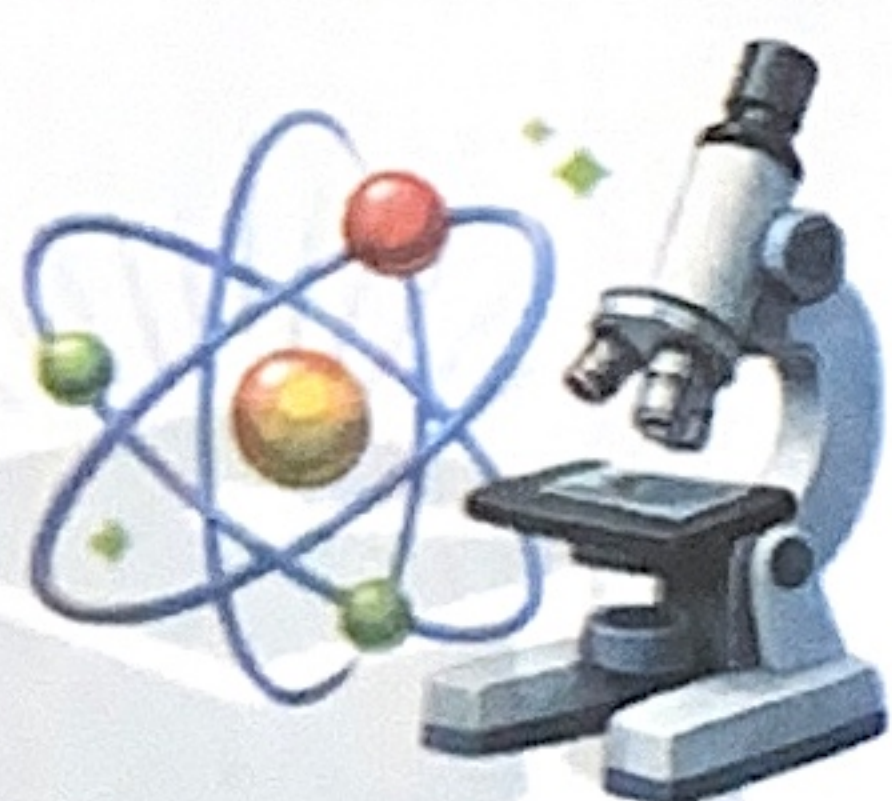
The stream you choose after **Class 10** can influence your future career path, higher education options, and professional opportunities. Therefore, it is very important to understand all available options before making this decision.

Don't Choose a Stream Under Pressure



One of the biggest mistakes students make is choosing a stream under pressure from society, friends, or relatives

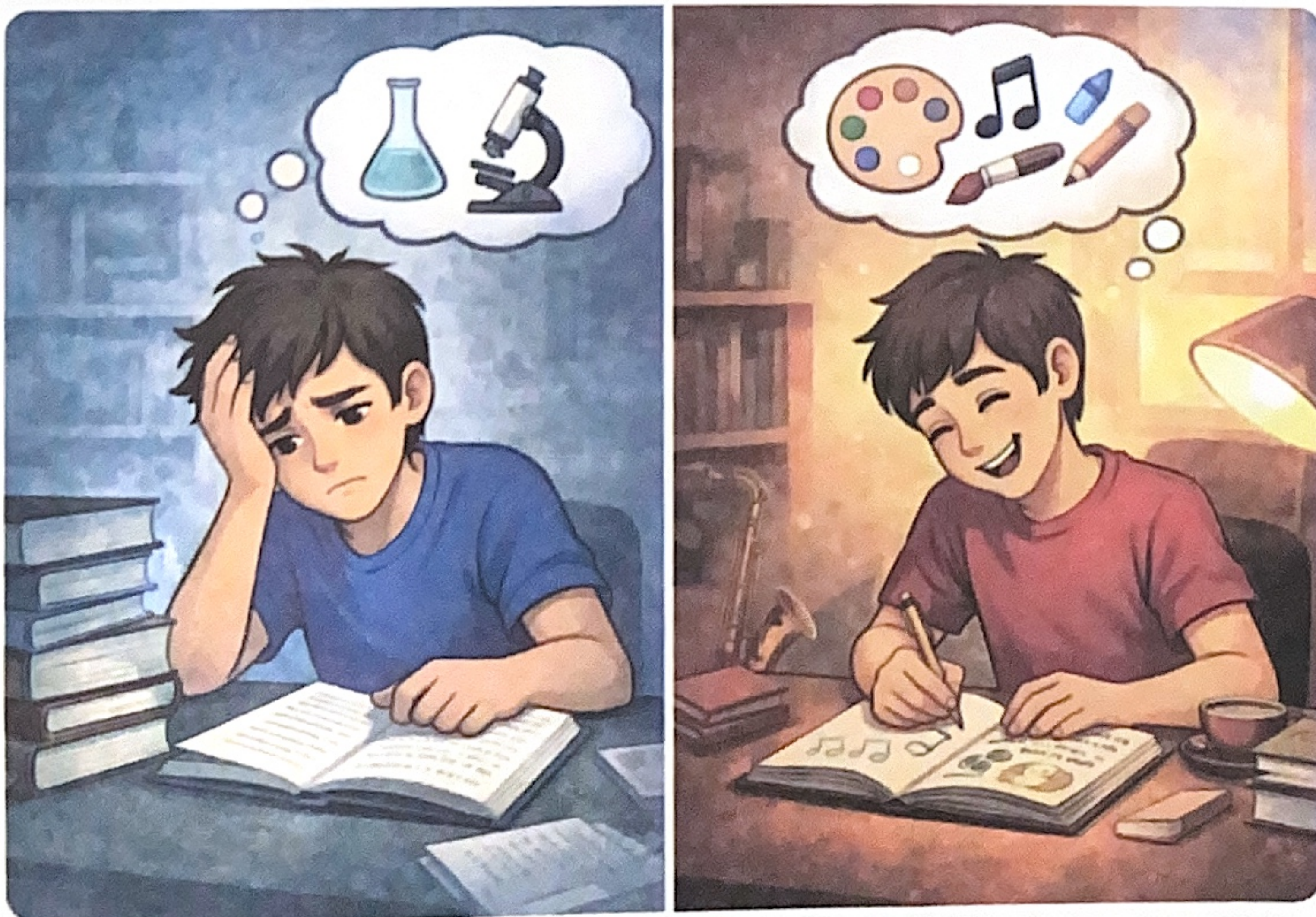
Some common examples include:

- Choosing the same stream as friends to stay together.
- Choosing a stream only because of family expectations.

Remember, every student is different. What works for someone else may not be the best choice for you.

Your decision should be based on **what you enjoy learning** and **what you want to become in the future**.

Choose Based on Your Interests and Strengths



The best way to choose a stream is to understand yourself.

Ask yourself questions like:

- ➡ Which subjects do I enjoy the most?
- ➡ Which subjects am I naturally good at?
- ➡ What type of career excites me?

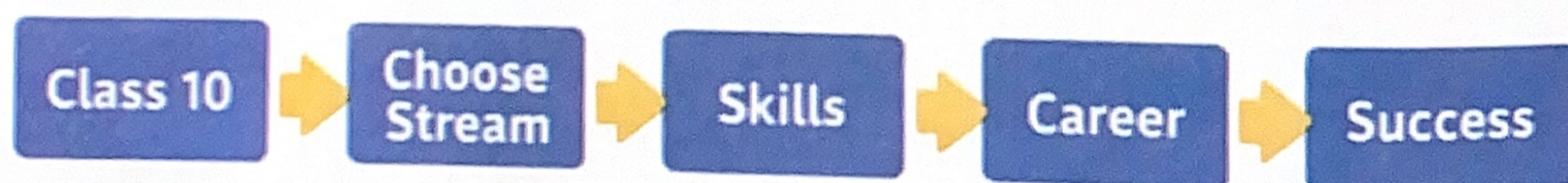


For example:

- ✔ If you enjoy **math and problem solving**, Science or Commerce may suit you.
- ✔ If you enjoy **business, money, and economics**, Commerce might be a great choice.
- ✔ If you enjoy **reading, writing, history, or psychology**, Arts/Humanities could be the right option.

When you choose a stream that matches your interests, studying becomes more enjoyable and success becomes easier.
