

## No Bike to School for Students - Circular

We hope this letter finds you and your family in good health and high spirits.

In our continued efforts to ensure the safety and well-being of all our students, we wish to inform you that effective immediately, students are strictly prohibited from bringing and riding bikes within the school premises. This decision has been taken after careful consideration of the potential risks and safety concerns associated with students riding bikes to school.

### Key Points of the Circular:

#### 1. No Bikes Allowed on School Grounds:

- Students are not permitted to bring bikes to school under any circumstances. This rule applies during school hours as well as during any school-related activities.

#### 2. Awareness of RTO Regulations:

- As responsible members of the community, it is imperative that we adhere to the Road Transport Office (RTO) regulations concerning the use of motor vehicles by minors.
- According to the RTO rules, individuals under the age of 18 are not legally permitted to ride motorbikes on public roads. This regulation is strictly enforced to ensure the safety of young riders and other road users.
- Parents allowing their underage children to ride bikes, even for private tuitions or other purposes, may face legal consequences. Non-compliance with these regulations not only puts the child's safety at risk but also holds the parents accountable under the law.

#### 3. Student Safety:

- The primary reason for this prohibition is to safeguard our students from potential accidents and injuries. We urge parents to consider safer modes of transportation for their children's commute to school and other activities.
- We recommend carpooling, riding bicycle (for shorter distance) or using school transportation services where available or whichever is safe and secure.

**We Seek Your Cooperation:** We kindly request all parents and guardians to support this initiative by ensuring that your children do not bring bikes to school and comply with the RTO regulations. Your cooperation is vital in maintaining a safe and secure environment for all students.
